IFEES/RAEE Colloquium Pre Conference Workshops Proposal

Purpose: Leverage IFEES and RAEE's Colloquium events to have Russian and international attendees participate in selected workshops related to the themes of these events.

Strategy:

1. Conference organizers make an invitation to submit pre-conference workshop proposals. Submit a one page workshop title, description and leaders CV.
2. Workshops have to be self sustainable – they could require a registration fee to cover for logistics if need be (to be determined by IFEES/RAEE program committees)
3. Workshops will be scheduled for May 19-22nd and will approximately be ½ day long. They would be open to all IFEES and RAEE Colloquium participants duly registered. Some of the possible workshops topics include (not confirmed):
